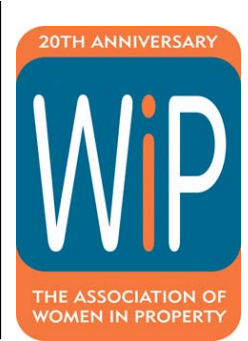
Property & Construction Charity Ball
